NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Divided Sexes -Dogs and Bitches) Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran, 7 Yrs & Under 10 Yrs

Veteran, 10 Yrs & Older

Winners of the Veteran Classes may compete in Best of Breed Competition if otherwise undefeated the day of the show. The AKC allows spayed bitches and castrated dogs to be shown in the Veterans Class at Independent Specialty Shows, and are eligible for competition in Best of Breed. *Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules.*

Best Puppy involves the winners of the 6-9- and 9-12-month puppy classes (**BBE Puppy class not included in competition for Best Puppy**). Even if one puppy has beaten another by virtue of receiving Winners or Reserve from the classes, all four puppies return to the ring for the judging of Best Puppy. This is a separate, non-regular class judged by the Best of Breed judge. What happened in the regular classes has no bearing on the Best Puppy award.

Best Bred-by-Exhibitor will include the winners of the four Bred-by-Exhibitor Classes (BBE Puppy 6- 12 months, BBE Adult 12+ months)

SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

(Saturday only)

Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes or at the regular entry fee. Indicate your Veteran Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided.

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches:

Veteran, 7 Yrs & Under 10 Yrs

Veteran, 10 Yrs & Older

DIVISION OF ENTRY MONEY AS PRIZES (Puppy & Veteran)

30% of total entry fees will be retained by the club for expenses. The remaining 70% will be divided in each class as follows: 1st - 25%; 2nd - 20%; 3rd - 15%; 4th - 10%.

AKC 4-6 Months Beginner Puppy Competition (Friday only)

- One combined class, not divided by sex, will be offered for puppies that are at least 4 months of age but not more than 6 months of age on the date of the competition. Best of Breed Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex Puppy will be chosen.
- An AKC registration number or AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed. A foreign-born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.
- Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.
- Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class but must be handled by a non-professional handler. Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. Dogs may not be exhibited by current assistants and household members of a professional handler. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/ weekend. Minors (under 18) with amateur status who reside with professional handlers and current assistants to professional handlers that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may personally exhibit dogs in the Four and under Six Months Puppy Competition.
- AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in Rules Applying to Dog Shows will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.
- Exhibitors should plan on opening the mouth of their puppy for the judges.
- Breed standard disqualifications such as color, height, weight or dentition shall not be a point of consideration in the judging process
- Each entry will receive a dog toy

Telephone and unsigned entries **CANNOT** be accepted.

Entry fee shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show COmmittee.

Canadian exhibitors must make fees payable in US funds.

Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of the entry without the Agreement and Rules from the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

Errors on Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

A recording fee of 50 cents and an event fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club, Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fee is collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2)

All dogs must be held on leash except when in the exercise area or crated.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

No entry shall be made or accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Judging schedule and map to the show site will be mailed as soon as possible after the closing of entries.

NO SMOKING in the building.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

Please keep the area cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers **MUST** keep them clean.

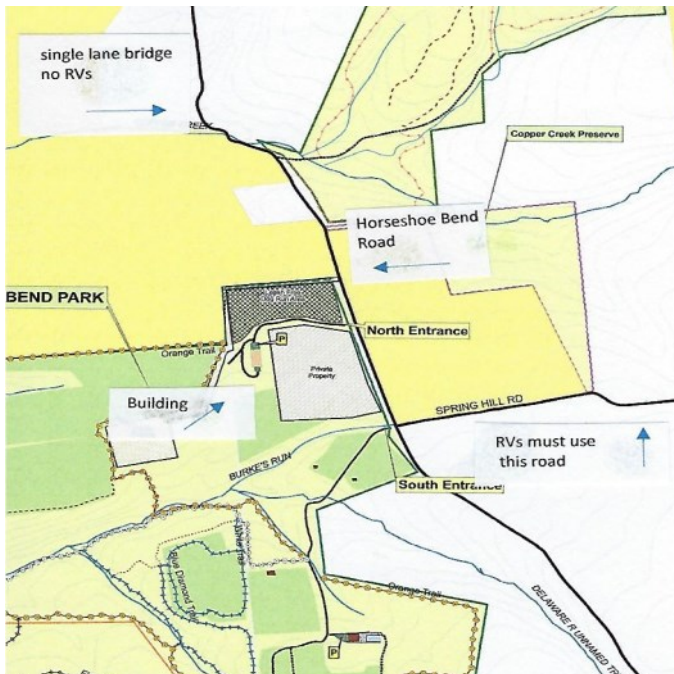

From Flemington-

Take Route 12 West. Turn left onto CR 519 Kingwood Road. Turn right onto Spring Hill Road. At the stop sign, turn right onto Horseshoe Bend Road. Do not go straight into South Entrance. North Entrance is on the left in 2/10 mile

Note: RVs when you turn right on Horseshoe Bend Road, there is a sign for no vehicle over 15 tons, 30 feet in length and trailers. This is for a bridge past the show entrance.



From Route 12 East- Turn left onto CR 519 and proceed as above

Route 12 is convenient to reach from Route 202

You can also access Horseshoe Bend Road directly from Route 12 (Kingwood Ave.). This road is not for RVs and is very winding. It has a one lane bridge with weight restrictions.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
